For an infraction, up to \$250 on each first offense, unless otherwise specified by statute: b. For a failure to appear/pay fine, a civil penalty of up to \$300, or an arrest/bench warrant, the addition of new misdemeanor charges, and/or license holds and suspensions.
