

Unlawful Detainer Mediation

Unlawful Detainer mediation is offered to all Monterey County residents through a grant-funded program in cooperation with the Superior Court of California, Monterey County, the Monterey College of Law, and Mandell-Gisnet Center for Conflict Management. It is a FREE program designed to serve the Community.

In order to participate in the FREE Unlawful Detainer Mediation program, **BOTH** parties must agree to mediation, which can be initiated either by you **OR** by the conflict center by calling (831) 582-4000 and asking for the ADR Coordinator. Please fax the form to The Monterey College of Law at (831) 582-4095 or email to courtadr@mandellgisnetcenter.org. Once a fully-completed form has been received and signed by both parties, you will be notified by telephone, email, or mail of the date and time of the mediation. All mediations will be held at the Monterey College of Law located at 100 Col. Durham Street, Seaside, CA 93955.

If you are not comfortable with the English language, it is the responsibility of the litigants to provide their own interpreter who can interpret for them in the mediation. The Superior Court of California, Monterey County, the Monterey College of Law, and The Mandell-Gisnet Center for Conflict Management DO NOT provide interpreters.
