### Huisheng Xie DVM, MS, PhD Founder and President of Chi University

Dr. Xie has 38 years clinical, teaching and research experience in veterinary acupuncture and TCVM. He has trained over 10,000 veterinarians to practice TCVM worldwide. Dr. Xie's education includes advanced training in veterinary medicine, veterinary acupuncture, and human acupuncture. Dr. Xie has authored 20 books and over 100 peer-reviewed papers. His textbooks, including *Xie's Veterinary Herbology*, *Xie's Veterinary Acupuncture* and *Traditional Chinese Veterinary Medicine-Fundamental Principles*, have been used for TCVM training programs around the world. Dr. Xie continues to teach and develop educational courses and programs at Chi University, serves as a full clinical professor at University of Florida's College of Veterinary Medicine, and is an honorary professor at China Agricultural University, South China Agricultural University and China Southwest University.



### Chee May Wong DVM, CVA, CVCH, CVTP, CVFT, CTCVMP, MSTCVM

Dr. Chee May Wong graduated with a DVM from University Putra Malaysia (UPM) in 2003 and has practiced in small animal medicine and emergency practice for eighteen years and established her own private clinics in Kuala Lumpur. In 2013, Dr. Wong began pursuing an education in TCVM at the Chi Institute (now Chi University) and earned a Certified Veterinary Acupuncturist (CVA, 2013), Certified Veterinary Chinese Herbalist (CVCH, 2017), Certified Veterinary Tui-na Practitioner (CVTP, 2017), Certified Veterinary Food Therapist (CVFT, 2017) with Dean's List recognition, Certified Traditional Chinese Veterinary Medicine Practitioner (CTCVMP, 2018) and Master's of Traditional Chinese Veterinary Medicine (MS-TCVM, 2019). Dr. Wong, Director of Chi Malaysia, tutor, lab instructor, and examiner has published and presented her case & research studies including "Integrative Medical Approach to Anaplasmosis in a Dog," "TCVM Approach to Acute Pelvic Limb Paralysis in a Dog," "The Effectiveness of Integrating Gui Pi Tang with Conventional Medicines in the Treatment of Thrombocytopenia in Dogs: A Retrospective Study." Her mission is to save more lives, especially in emergency critical care cases, by using the latest integrative medical approach with Traditional Chinese veterinary medicine treatment regime.



### Roger Clemmons DVM, MS, PhD, DACVIM (Neurology), CVA, CVFT

Known for his progressive and charismatic teaching style, Dr. Clemmons practiced neurology and neurosurgery and taught veterinary and graduate students with the University of Florida for 35 years. He is a board-certified specialist in Neurology, has published over 100 peer-reviewed original studies, reviews, papers and abstracts and given numerous presentations, both in the US and abroad. Dr. Clemmons has had an active research program and is known for his work on platelet physiology and in the study of neurodegenerative diseases such as degenerative myelopathy. He has developed a number of innovative neurosurgical techniques including fixation of atlantoaxial subluxation and Wobbler's syndrome. Dr. Clemmons received a certified veterinary acupuncturist (CVA) from the Chi Institute (now Chi University) in 2000 and TCVM Food Therapy (CVFT) in 2009. He integrates Veterinary Acupuncture, Herbal Medicine and nutrition into his practice. He is a national and international speaker in the field of neurology and the science of veterinary acupuncture.



### Ying Choi Chong DVM, CVA, CVTP

Dr. Ying Choi Chong graduated from Universiti Putra Malaysia with a DVM. Although Dr. Chong was R&D Executive of Bayer Malaysia from 1999 – 2002, his primary focus was still in the small animal field. In 2002, he left Bayer to establish his own small animal practice in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia and has since been a small animal practitioner and veterinary surgeon. Dr. Chong's interests in TCVM (Traditional Chinese Veterinary Medicine) led him to enroll with The Chi Institute (now Chi University) in 2014 where he graduated as a Certified Veterinary Acupuncturist (CVA). He pursued further education in Chinese herbal medicine and *Tui-na* and, in 2017, Dr. Chong became Malaysia's first Certified Veterinary *Tui-na* Practitioner (CVTP). In 2020, Dr. Chong presented his case study, "Treatment of Tracheal Collapse using TCVM," during the 22<sup>nd</sup> Annual International Conference on TCVM in Reddick, Florida. Dr. Chong is the lab instructor of Chi Malaysia.





## CVA PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The course begins with an overview of fundamental aspects of Chinese Medicine, including Yin-Yang and Five Elements theory, which serve as a foundation for case diagnoses and treatment presented later in the class. A variety of acupuncture techniques are taught, including electro-acupuncture, aqua-acupuncture, moxibustion, etc. in addition to conventional "dry" needling. In hands-on acupoint labs with live animals, students learn acupuncture points on dogs.

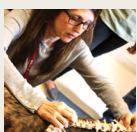

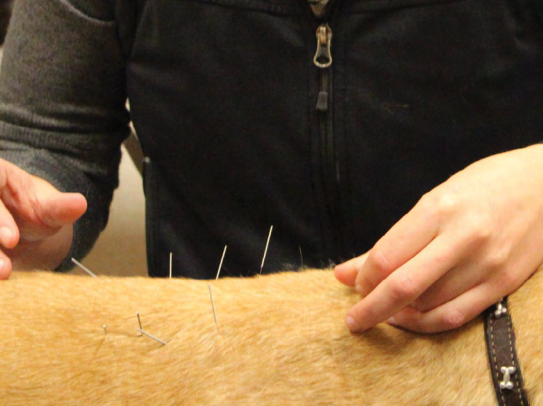
