

Case Report Guidelines for all Certificates

Your case report should describe treatment over a period of at least 3 months, with at least 5 visits or follow-ups and should be around 5 pages long. Please add the dates of each treatment and follow up. Some Important points to include are:

- History
- TCVM Diagnosis
- Rationale of treatment
- Description of each treatment (points, techniques and other modalities) and follow up
- Summary

Note: Acupuncture, Food Therapy, Tui-na, and Palliative certifications require 1 case report; Herbal Certification requires 3 case reports. Certification fees must be paid when submitting your first case report.

Be sure to include your name, class, and page number on every page. When you are ready to submit the case report, you can email it as a **Word or PDF attachment** to report@chiu.edu. Once we receive your case report, we will acknowledge via email that your case report was received. Please note that it may take 4-6 weeks for your report to come back with a “Pass” or Fail” grade.
